Individually:

Stephanie Sottile has a Bachelor's Degree in Theatre from Hofstra University where she was classically trained in acting for the stage as well and television and film. She also has studied privately with John Palotta of the Collective Theatre. She's been in the Off-Broadway drama, *Echoes*; played Emily in *Our Town*; and talked about her private parts in *The Vagina Monologues*. Craving something non-classical, she has studied long-form improvisation and sketch comedy at the Upright Citizen's Brigade Theatre since 2007 as well as with private coaches. She was in the sketch group, Harry T and the MCs for *UCB Theatre's Longest Sketch Ever* as part of the 2007 NY Comedy Festival. Besides The Un-Wanted, she is a member of the long-running sketch group, I Got Your Monkey. As for improvisation, she is a member of the improv troupes, Bully and Supercrab as well as her two-person improv duo, Lowblow.

Harry Terjanian has been performing stand up since 2001, starting at the tender age of 18. He has also appeared on MTV's "The Freshmen," the Morgue Art Film, "Won-Ton Baby," as well as a producer/writer/on-air personality on XM Satellite Radio. He also has studied long-form improvisation and at the Upright Citizen's Brigade Theatre since 2001 and is a member of the improv troupe, Wolfman.

As a Stand-Up Comedian:

In addition to playing major clubs in New York City, Harry has toured clubs, colleges, and theaters across America, playing to audiences of hundreds and thousands at high capacity venues such as New York's Town Hall Theater, Chicago's McCormick Convention Center, Syracuse University, U-Mass, NYU, and many others, as well as opening for the likes of *30 Rock's* Judah Friedlander.

He has taken part in several national comedy festivals including being a runner-up in the New York Underground Comedy Festival's Emerging Comics Competition, a finalist at the New York Comedy Festival's Andy Kaufman Awards, and a finalist in the Disney sponsored *Do You Think You're Funny?* Contest.

As a Stage Performer:

Harry is a regular at the Upright Citizen's Brigade Theater where he's written/performed his one-man show, the "No Fact's Zone," as well as several critically acclaimed sketch comedy shows as part of the HammerKatz sketch group.

He is also part of a sketch duo, The Un-Wanted with Stephanie Sottile. The Un-Wanted has performed at many highly acclaimed theatres in the New York City including the National Comedy Theatre, Under St. Marks Theatre, Theatre For The New City, the People's Improv Theatre, the Upright Citizen's Brigade Theatre, and many others. They are currently working on bringing their show, *I Hate You: A Couple's Love Story*, around New York and surrounding cities.

He is currently working on another one-man show in conjunction with the Bleeker St Theater and is a recipient of the Emerging Comics of New York Award for best sketch group for his work with HammerKatz.
